Business, Finance, and Marketing Education

The business and marketing education program in Ohio is a career-technical program of instruction offered through Ohio's public schools to (1) teach business, finance, hospitality and marketing, (2) improve the techniques of business and customer service, and (3) impart an understanding of the social, civic, and economic responsibilities of those engaged in America's free, competitive society. Business, finance, and marketing education provides training for students interested in a career in business occupations. Students study the functions of business which include distribution, financing, marketing-information management, promotion, product/service management, pricing, and selling. They also study economics, management, and business concepts.

DECA

DECA is the co-curricular component of the business and marketing education program that provides student activities. DECA prepares emerging leaders and entrepreneurs in marketing, finance, hospitality and management in high schools and colleges around the globe. The activities enhance their preparation for college and careers by providing co-curricular programs that integrate into classroom instruction, applying learning in the context of business, connecting to business and the community and promoting competition. The student members use their DECA experience to become academically prepared, community oriented, professionally responsible, experienced leaders. Membership in DECA is open to all students who are enrolled in a state approved career-technical education program.

The Executive Council of Ohio DECA, Inc.

Ohio DECA Executive Council is composed of 12 members. The council has several purposes. The most important job is to meet with their district teachers and students to gather feedback about Ohio DECA activities. The council also provides suggestions to the state adviser. Ultimately, though, the state adviser makes all decisions related to the organization. It is still important to hear the opinions and suggestions of our student members and advisers. The council meets twice yearly and discusses issues related to our conferences and our operations. The Executive Council helps advisors understand and get involved in DECA activities. The Executive Council serves an advisory purpose. They suggest procedures and policies to the Ohio DECA Board of Directors. The Board of Directors considers these recommendations to establish guidelines for the professional operation of Ohio DECA.

The Ohio DECA Board of Directors works with the state advisor to establish guidelines for the operation of the organization. The Board of Directors is made up of a group of industry leaders and elected DECA advisors.
